### English

Reading Texts: Charlotte's Web and Roman Myths and Legends.

#### Writing

We will be writing a narrative, producing letters for Year 2 to tell them what Coppice is like and finally, will be writing an Information book about Romans.

At home: Reading is a big focus for us and spelling. Please read everyday with your child and practise their Year 3 and 4 Common Exception Words.

### Maths

### Science

### Music
