



English


Reading: We will be studying "Kick" by Mitch Johnson.

Maths

This half term we are building on our prior learning and studying: statistics, geometry (position and direction), measures and volume.



You can help your child by: practicing converting units of measure or engaging in practical measuring activities to develop accuracy and estimation skills.

Geography

We will be studying rivers. This will include developing an understanding of the processes that form and shape river features. We also be looking at the Water Cycle by exploring the journey of water through our world.



Music

We will be continuing to build our guitar playing and composing skills, with lessons in school with Mr Webb, our specialist music teacher.



RE

We are looking at the best way to show commitment in Christianity and Sikhism.



French



We are continuing our study of French by investigating our environment and seasons.




PE

This term we will be taking part in track and field athletic activities. Additionally, the children will be receiving specialist tuition from visiting cricket coaches and taking part in a local Solihull Borough Cricket Festival.



Science

We will be continuing to study the science topic "Earth and Beyond". As part of this we will learn about the position and movement of the moon, Earth and planets relative to each other.



We will then move onto the topic of Life Cycles, insects and amphibians which is always a popular topic. Moving finally onto Human Development, focusing on the stages of life and how each one changes us.

Computing

This term we will be using Purple Mash to learn about create concept maps and word processing.

In the first half term we will learning all about the art and techniques of Claude Monet the world famous Impressionist painter.



In the second half term we will focus on DT and make cross-stitch bookmarks.
